





### **New Zealand's Wine Industry since the GFC**



## Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BIMSB)














 Air freight pumps and pump parts imported from Italy, Nov 2019, destined for NZ vineyards


 2 live male and 2 live female BMSB intercepted at transitional facility in Auckland

Surveillance for new unwanted pests, diseases and weeds










# Resources to help you become a Biosecurity Champion


